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Please write your research proposal according to the following guidelines.

The document should not exceed 2 pages (double-spaced, Times or Arial font) plus References.

Proposals must contain the following elements:

1. INTRODUCTION to the project – describe the rationale for this research.
2. OBJECTIVE of your proposed work. For example: to test a hypothesis, develop a working assay, set up an experimental protocol, extend an existing theory, review the literature, or write a case report.
3. EXPERIMENTAL DESIGN
 - For experimental research, briefly describe the rationale and design of your studies and method of analysis.
 - For literature reviews and case reports, describe 1-3 specific aims of your work and the methodology to be employed in addressing each of these aims.
4. ROLE of the student scholar – please be specific!
 - Time commitment (Student must commit at least 20 hours per week to the project to be eligible for award)
 - Supervision (How frequently will student meet with mentor?)
 - Expected scholarly product (Examples: internal or external conference presentation, educational tool, quality improvement protocol, publication)
5. REFERENCES (minimum of TWO, maximum of SIX) from the published literature that support your proposed work. These must be listed as a bibliography.
